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SYNOPSIS

The film 'The Conductor' is based on the true story of the Dutch born Antonia Brico. In the late 1920's she was the world's first woman who successfully conducted a large symphony orchestra. Until recent, women barely succeeded to reach the world's top ranking conductors.
